## LIFE BEHIND THE CONSOLE

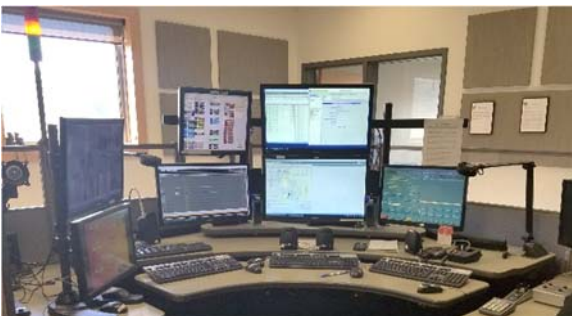


Thinking of changing your career or have an interest in becoming a 911-Dispatcher? This internship is a great opportunity for anyone who wishes to experience the internal operations of a 911-Dispatch Center and those thinking of entering the career of a 911-Dispatcher. The knowledge gained through this program could help prepare those interested for a new career as a 911 Emergency Dispatcher!

Chisago County Dispatchers are the vital link to the public and all emergency services within Chisago County. They strive for efficiency; helping to save lives, protect property, and to assist the public and public safety response personnel.

They are instrumental in making Chisago County a safer community to live, work, and visit.

Chisago County Dispatchers will work individually with each Intern on a wide variety of topics and hands-on activities. Each Intern selected will be required to complete a 40 hour intern course from June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 through July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Scheduled hours will be flexible and can be scheduled around the Intern's personal schedule. The 911-Dispatch Intern will be learning in a live and fast paced environment. All Intern's will be under direct supervision, with detailed instructions and guidance.
