## Emergency Preparedness

Public health issues are present in all kinds of emergencies and disasters, including natural disasters such as floods or tornados, infectious disease outbreaks, or manmade disasters such as chemical spills or acts of terrorism. We prepare for and respond to emergencies and assist communities in the recovery process.

Specific Local Public Health emergency preparedness duties include:

- Provide leadership, develop and maintain relationships with community partners.
- Identify public health hazards, vulnerabilities and build the capacity to respond.
- Develop and maintain plans and exercise them.
- Participate in surveillance and monitoring activities to anticipate and detect potential public health threats and implement appropriate response actions.
- Develop and maintain a training system of public health workforce readiness, deployment and response.
- Provide expertise in developing and disseminating key information for community partners
