Vaccine Updates for Chisago County

Chisago County Public Health is working diligently on planning and administering the COVID-19 vaccine to Chisago County residents. Chisago County Public Health is still prioritizing appointments to high risk groups, but with the new eligibility expansion Governor Walz put in place on March 30, 2021, Public Health encourages all Chisago County residents to visit the Chisago County COVID-19 Vaccine Information Page (Google: *Chisago County Vaccine* in the search bar) to register for an appointment. Appointments through public health to receive the vaccine can be made for Chisago County residents 18 years of age and older.

Additional vaccine opportunities are listed on Vaccine Information webpage which includes, local healthcare provider opportunities, VaccineFinder link to find out which local pharmacies are providing the vaccine in your area and other vaccine options through the Minnesota Department of Health. If you are a resident of Chisago County and would like to make an appointment through your local health department; a live link is posted every Monday by 1:00 p.m. on this webpage to register online or via telephone for an appointment for the upcoming vaccine clinic.

More vaccine is arriving every week, but demand is still exceeding supply. Public Health encourages Chisago County residents to keep visiting the Chisago County Vaccine Information Page for the latest updates and vaccine opportunities. Public Health thanks everyone for their patience and continued support, and understands the importance of vaccinating as many people as possible in a timely manner to reduce the severity of a new COVID-19 surge in Minnesota.
