



TRAIL CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Sunrise Prairie Regional Trail Project CSAH10 (Stark Rd), Harris to 410th Street, North Branch (County Project No.13-SPT-23) (GMRPTC22-05)

Where:

- Sunrise Prairie Regional Trail Extension (North Branch to Harris)
- From the intersection of CSAH 10 in Harris to 410th Street in North Branch
 - CSAH 30- Public Right of Way

What has been happening:

Phase 1 of the Sunrise Prairie Trail Project in North Branch has been paved. Phase 1 consists of the first mile of trail from 410th street to 420th street in North Branch along the CSAH 30 Public Right of Way. This section of trail is still currently **CLOSED** to the public until final work has been completed which includes the installation of pedestrian ramps, final grading, landscaping, and seeding.

Phase 2 will be the construction of the remainder of the trail from 420th street in North Branch to CSAH 10 in Harris. Phase 2 will begin shortly with rough grading and pipe installation.

When: Start date: June 28, 2023

- Anticipated completion date: Mid- September 2023

Traffic Impacts and what to Expect:

- **NOTE:** Because the trail corridor runs parallel to CSAH 30 please be aware of construction near this stretch of the highway, CSAH will remain open during construction as well as individual driveway access to property owners. In order to complete the work and maintain access please stay clear and avoid construction limits, watch and pay extra attention to all trail work signage, construction vehicles and/or equipment throughout the project limits. Proper personal protective equipment, including high visibility clothing is required for this project.

Phase 1 – Landscaping and Seeding (anticipated to begin on June 28, 2023)

Phase 2 – Rough Grading and Pipe Installation (anticipated to begin on June 28, 2023)

- Access to homes within the construction work zone will be maintained. However, there may be times when access to your driveway will be limited, but we will work closely with you and the contractor to provide proper notification through these instances.
- Trail construction signage will be posted prior to and during work. Travel with caution throughout the active work zone.
- Watch for traffic, stay clear and avoid construction limits in the public right of way.
