

295TH STREET NEIGHBORHOOD RETROFIT

RAIN GARDENS

The runoff water from the neighborhood around 295th Street in Lindstrom flows through a culvert along the ditch and into a large pipe that outlets directly into South Center Lake. At the intersection of 295th Street and Nathan Avenue, a series of 5 rain gardens will help slow this water down, allowing some of it to infiltrate into the ground.

Construction began on the gardens in the late fall of 2014. A large early snowstorm put the construction on hold until the spring of 2015. The gardens will be planted with colorful native plants.
