

# ELM STREET/2<sup>ND</sup> AVE. RAIN GARDEN

## LINDSTROM, MN

The neighborhood around Pumphouse Park in Lindstrom is part of one watershed that drains to an active gully on the bank of North Lindstrom Lake. Several phases of rain gardens have been installed along different streets in the neighborhood. The earliest gardens were installed along Maple Street. The next year, gardens were installed at the park itself and at the intersection of Elm Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. In the spring of 2015, another rain garden was constructed in a prime location. It is across the street from the garden at the intersection of Elm Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and captures runoff that up until now was still not being treated.
